Dreamgirls, Marcus Center Uihlein Hall, 1/5-1/10

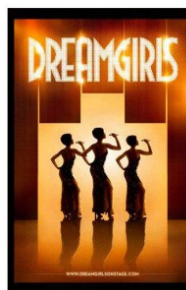
